SSW Zoom Webinar:

You must register in advance for this Zoom webinar. If you did not receive the Zoom webinar registration link, please make sure you registered for the workshop (<u>https://catcopy.ipac.caltech.edu/ssw/registration.php</u>) and email us at the email address above.

Note that registration for the Zoom webinar is *separate* from the regular workshop registration and you must be registered here first to be approved for the Zoom webinar registration.

Once your Zoom webinar registration is approved, you will receive a follow-up email with your individual link to join the webinar. You will use this same link for all 5 days of the workshop. Please do not share this link with anyone else.

A Zoom webinar is different from a Zoom meeting. As an attendee, you can see and hear the panelists and hosts, but will not be seen, and do not have permission to speak (unless granted by the host). If you are a workshop speaker, you will be added to the webinar as a panelist with full audio and video and screen sharing capability.

Pre-recorded Talks

Many of the workshop presentations have pre-recorded versions, which can be found on the <u>Sagan Summer Workshop YouTube playlist for the 2021 workshop</u>. Shorter versions of these

talks will be given during the live portion of the workshop, so it would be beneficial if you can view the longer versions ahead of time.
